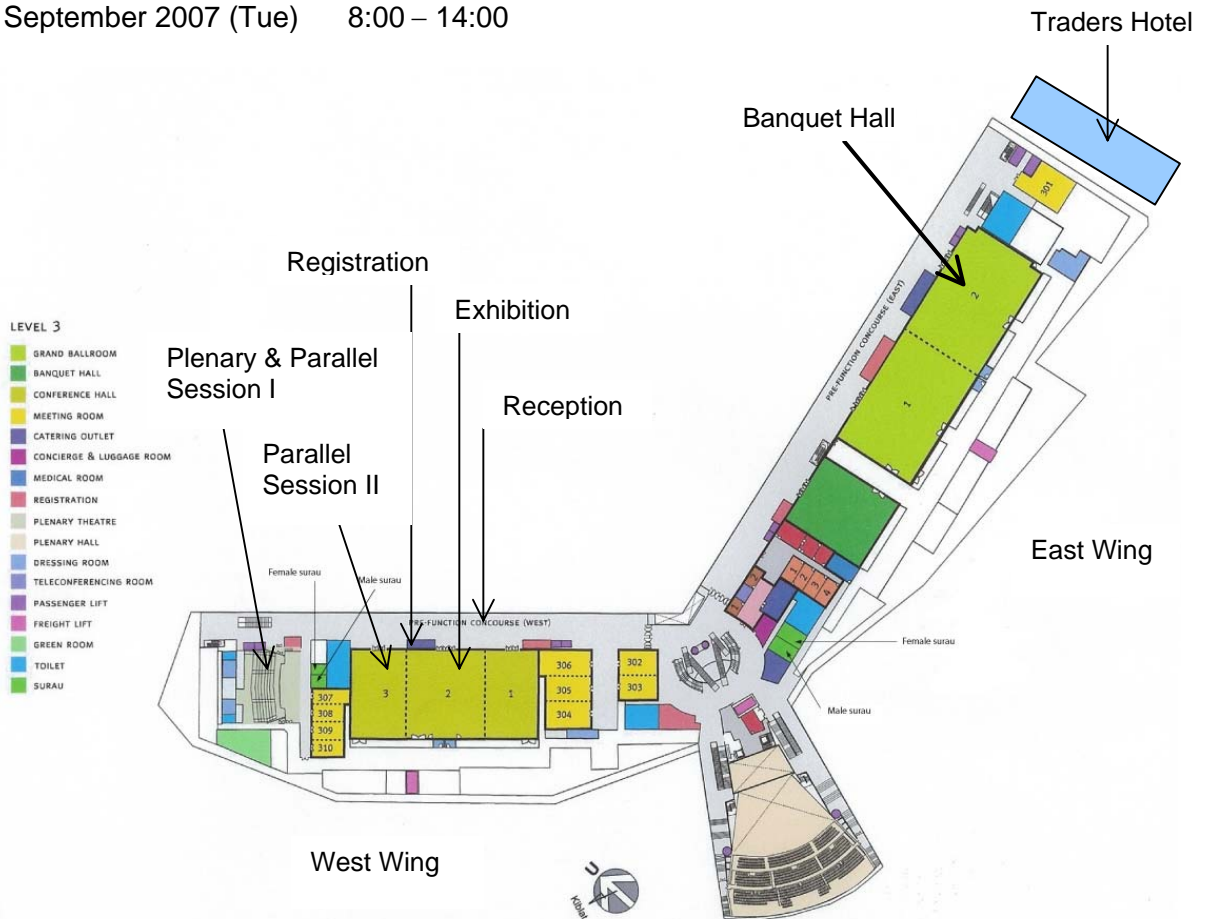

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Guidelines for Preparing a Manuscript for the Conference Proceedings

Length: The text should not exceed 8 pages, including illustrations, tables, etc. All texts and illustrations shall be in black and white only.

Language: All papers should be written in **English**.

Page Numbering: Do *not* include page numbers, they will be added later.

Format: MS Word shall be used throughout. In order to standardize the format of all the papers in the proceedings, please adhere to the following guidelines when producing your paper:

Paper size: A4 size

Margins: It should not be less than 25 mm all round.

Title of the paper: Your paper's title should be in **Arial font, 12 pt, centered and bold**. Below the title, include full information of the first author, including affiliation and address, followed by full information of the second, third, etc authors.

Abstract: Start with the abstract of your paper, 200 – 300 words in single-spaced, single column format and **Arial font, 10 pt**. List all keywords (maximum 5 words) at the bottom of the abstract.

Text: For the rest of the text, please use **Arial 10 pt**. Only text headings and sub-headings in the text should be in bold.

Contents of the text: i) Introduction ii) Experimental/Materials iii) Results and Discussions iv) Conclusion v) References.

Editing: All papers will be sent directly to the printer with minimum of editing, so kindly check the papers thoroughly before submitting, making sure that all figures and histograms are very clearly produced.

Submission: Please submit your full paper via email or send your CD to the Conference Secretariat by **15 July 2007**. CDs must be sent in a hardback envelope or with suitable protection from possible bending during postage.

Presentation: Each presentation will last for 20 minutes followed by a Q&A session for 5-10 minutes. Presenters are requested to use the conference computer rather than their own, to avoid delays and potential errors caused by switching machines during the conference. Presenters are advised to bring their presentation materials on a CD or memory stick, with the presenter's name included in the filename of the presentation materials, for the purpose of identification. During the conference, please load and test your presentation on the conference computer during the break before your session starts.

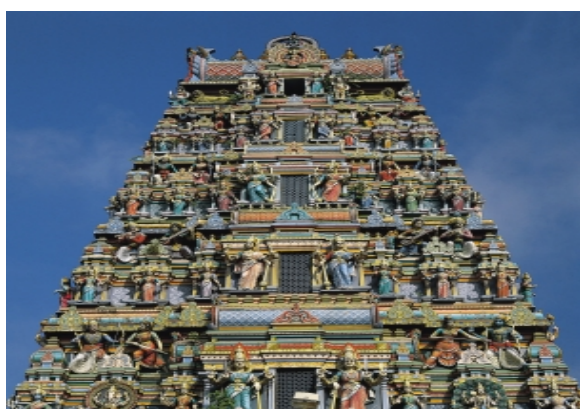

Malaysia

Malaysia is located in the heart of Southeast Asia. Malaysia is a land of fascinating sights and attractions. Rich in color and contrasts, her multi-faceted charm provides intriguing images that leave visitors to the country in awe. Kuala Lumpur

Kuala Lumpur, the capital of Malaysia, is a city of 244 square km with a population of nearly two million people and situated on the West Coast of Peninsular Malaysia. Malaysia runs on a normal eight-hour working day system with Saturdays and Sunday as days of rest. Private sector hours are generally from 9:00am to 5:00pm (Monday-Friday) while government office hours are usually from 8:00am to 5:00pm (Monday-Friday).

Shopping

Shops and other sales outlets in Malaysia are generally open on Saturday, Sunday and Public holidays as well as weekdays from 10:00 to 22:00. Visa and Mastercards are widely accepted at hotels, department stores, shops and restaurants.
